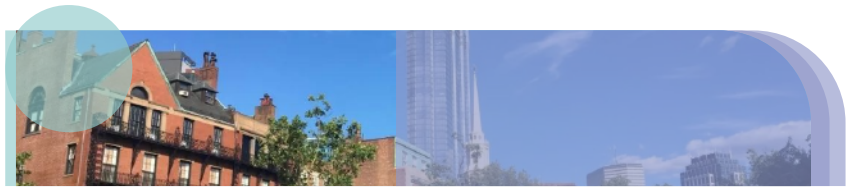
Registration Requirements:

- Age Requirement : 11-16 years old
- Camp Time : July 15, 2018 - July 29
- English Ability :
Basic listening and speaking ability
- Accommodation :
School dormitory or hotel
- School Qualifications :
Boston Gold Medal School, IB International Course authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization
- Certificate of Achievement :
Upon completion of the course, each student will be awarded a certificate of achievement by Gold Medal School



Where will we study ?

We will soon study IB courses in the International Baccalaureate World School located in Boston, which is announced as Gold & Silver Medal School by US News & World Report and most challenging school by Washington Post. Its principal is an outstanding alumnus of Harvard University, and students graduated from this school are admitted to world-class universities such as Harvard and Columbia University. In addition, the school is also authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization to provide IB International courses. All teachers in the school are authorized by Massachusetts and receive IB training certification.



At present, there are 55 countries and more than 500 schools around the world teaching IB courses. There are 59 IB international schools in China and their annual tuition fees are over RMB 200,000.

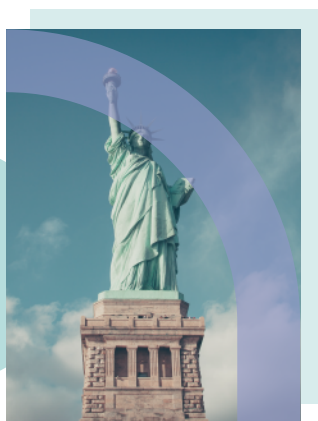
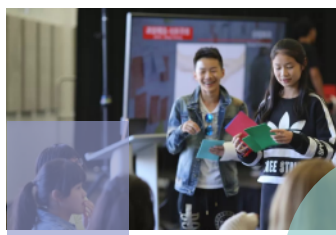
SCHEDULE
